The story of the world power's treatment with Iran in the contemporary era is a sad and heartbreaking one. The colonial powers have been all the time after imposing disgraceful covenants and agreements on Iran to separate parts of the country's soil and annex to that of theirs, attacking the country and killing its innocent citizens or depriving its people from their intrinsic rights and privileges.

Over the course past 100 years, Iran hasn't invaded nor attacked any country. Saddam had used all kinds of illegal and forbidden war tactics against the defenseless nation of Iran, including illicit chemical weapons provided to him by the U.S., UK and other Western states which cost the lives of more than 100,000 Iranians, but in response, Iranians never turned to such inhumane, appalling and unconventional alternatives.

Robin Wright once revealed in his 2008 book "Dreams and Shadows: the Future of the Middle East" that the CIA estimated in 1991 that Iran had suffered more than 50,000 casualties from Iraq's use of several chemical weapons, while today, the actual number of victims is estimated to more than 100,000, since the long term effects still cause casualties to this day.

It's said that after the United States, the UK, Soviet Union, France and Italy were the most prominent procurers of weaponry, military training

and financial assistance to Saddam Hussein in the years leading up to the Iran-Iraq war and during the years of war itself. In the same tough and intolerable years, there was nobody to assist Iran and they were simply the empty-handed Iranian youths who rushed up to the frontlines to defend the invaded soil of their country.

However, that war is ended now, and what remains in the memory of Iranians is the brutality of Saddam who massacred tens of thousands of innocent citizens with the complicity and connivance of the West.

Now, the United States and its client state, Israel, persistently accuse Iran of sponsoring terrorism, deliberately overlooking the fact that Iran has been continually at the forefront of fighting and countering terrorism and at the same time, a silent victim of the West's state-sponsored terrorism.

The bloodthirsty terrorist gang, MKO, which has enjoyed the backing and patronage of the United States and its European cronies since the victory of Iran's Islamic Revolution in 1979 is now seeking international support for finding a permanent residence after being sent away from the Camp Ashraf in Iraqi province of Diyala. The group is responsible for the lives of hundreds of Iranian citizens and tens of governmental officials and has proclaimed as its primary goal a regime change in Tehran with the support of Tel Aviv and Washington. The Western officials, for their part, have not hesitated to express support for the terrorist cult and in an effort which was an all-out declaration of war against Iran the European Union removed the name of MKO from its list of terrorist organizations in January 2009. Now, the U.S. officials are petitioning to persuade their government to do the same and give more room to MKO to carry out its anti-Iranian plans without being prosecuted as a terrorist organization.

And today, after the terrible years of war with Iraq and experiencing different plots and plans of the Westerners who seek to destabilize Iran at the expense of the life and security of Iranian nation, Tehran has come under escalating pressure over its nuclear program, being targeted with innumerable economic sanctions and war threats for simply trying to nationalize nuclear energy to be used for civilian purposes.

The United States and her allies, prompted by Israel are pressuring Tehran to give up its nuclear program or be penalized and even face graver

consequences such as a military strike. And ironically, all of those who call on Iran to surrender its nuclear rights are owners of nuclear weapons who have used their atomic warheads on other nations or otherwise have threatened them that they'll be doing so.

So, what's the crime of Iranian nation who should be subject to all kinds of harassment and discrimination by the world powers and their allies? The answer is quite simple, while at the same time, thoroughly complicated and problematical.

Iran is a country whose history has been interwoven with peaceful coexistence with the other nations. Up to this day that you're reading these lines, Iranians haven't ever been considered a colonial power while in some junctures of the history they possessed the capabilities of becoming a colonial power. No country in the contemporary age can claim or testify that Iranians have plotted to undermine their security and stability. Iran hasn't ever threatened any country with military expeditions to expand its ideology. The revolution of Iranians in 1979 was that of a kind of culture and religion. **H**ijab or Veil, takes the Centre stage whenever there is battle between truth and falsehood. It has always been a sensitive issue, but it recently received a great deal of attention due to legislation and proposed legislation in several European Countries e.g France, Germany, that can it's use in government institutions as well as educational institutions for who wear -Hijab-out of religious conviction the truth is obvious and indisputable. It is important to understand several points related to Hijab and modesty. The first point is that modesty had been the norm in history, if one were to peruse historical books of various times and ages, one would find modest covering of women in almost every society. The other point is that modesty is a component in several world religions, particularly in Judaism, Christianity, and Islam, it may come as surprise to many that it was not Islam that invented modesty or Hijab. This existed in the laws of religions revealed before Islam but with the final message given to Prophet Mohammed ( Peace be upon him) the order for Hijab was confirmed and finalized.

Hijab represents a women's submission to her creator and her connection with the faith while referring to it, Allah Almighty says: that is more suitable that they will be known..... But, while Hijab is a symbol, in reality it is much more than that, The following purposes and functions of Hijab will clarify this point. Hijab is a test for the Muslim Woman. It is clear from the Holy Quran and the Hadiths that Hijab is a religious obligation, which a woman has to undertake. There is no scholarly difference on this point and the Muslim Ummah has applied it for over 14 centuries. When a Muslim woman wears Hijab she is obeying and submitting to Allah. The following verses of the Holy Qur'an refer to the obligatory nature of Hijab: "And tell the believing women to reduce (some) of their vision and guard their private parts and not expose their adornment except that which ( necessarily ) appears therefore and to wrap ( a portion of) their head covers over their chest and not expose their adornment except to their husband, their fathers, their sons, their brothers, their sisters, their women's, that which their right hands possess, or those male attendants having no physical desire, or children who are not yet aware of the private aspects of women. And let them not stamp their feet to make known what they conceal of their adornment. And turn to Allah in repentance, all of you, O believers, that you might succeed ( Quran: 24:31) Also Allah says: 'O Prophet 'tell your wives and your daughters and the women of the believers to bring down over themselves ( part ) of their other garments. That is more suitable that they will be known and not be

abused. And ever is Allah forgiving and merciful ( Quran: 33: 59)

A woman who wears Hijab liberates herself from the vain and selfish desire to show off her beauty and to compete with other women around her. With the Hijab, a woman, doesn't have to live up to society's expectations of what is desirable, and she no longer has to use her beauty to obtain recognition or acceptance from those around in the chapter of Al-ahzaab mentioned above, Allah Almighty says what means " that is more suitable that they will be known and not be abused" thus, one of the functions of Hijab is to protect women from abuse and harm. This particularly includes various forms of sexual abuse and harassment, which are prevalent in societies in which few women cover. Men often get mixed signals and believe that women want their advances by the way they reveal their bodies the Hijab on the contrary, sends a signal to men that the wearer is a modest and chaste woman who should be not annoyed.

The word Hijab is taken from the Arabic word " Hajaba" which means to hide or to conceal. In the present society, wearing Hijab refers to the covering of Muslim Women or the Muslim Women dress or veil. Today we see many non-Muslim and Muslim Women asking about "why do Muslim Women wear Hijab?" The answer to this is that Muslim Women are ordered by Allah to cover their head and wear Hijab and veils. Covering the beauty for a women is for her honor and protection rather than suppression. Importance of Hijab and virtues of Hijab can be judged by Quranic verses. Hijab or the covering of Muslim Women is mentioned in Quran clearly. In short I mention here again what Allah says in the Quran about Hijab.

1. Hijab is for modest and respectable women.
2. Hijab is parity.
3. Hijab is honorable.
4. Hijab is righteousness.
5. Hijab is for successful women and believing women.

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## Israeli PM Netanyahu in India to deepen links, Disappointed over India's stand on Palestine in UN



New Delhi: Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu Monday inspected a ceremonial guard of honor at India's presidential palace and laid a floral wreath at the memorial of India's independence leader Mohandas Gandhi during his first visit to the country. Netanyahu is scheduled to meet with Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi later Monday to discuss defense, trade and energy ties. "This is the dawn of a new era in the great friendship between India and Israel," Netanyahu told reporters at the presidential palace. He described the visit as "deeply moving for my wife and me and for the entire people of Israel." The visit marks 25 years since India and Israel established diplomatic relations. Last year Modi visited Israel, becoming the first Indian prime

minister to do so. During the Cold War, India didn't have open relations with Israel, leaning heavily in favor of the Palestinians. But over the last 25 years, ties between the two countries have warmed.

Netanyahu arrived in New Delhi on Sunday and was met on the tarmac by Modi, who engulfed the Israeli leader in his trademark bear hug. But the visit also comes weeks after India's vote in favor of a U.N. resolution denouncing President Donald Trump's recognition of Jerusalem as Israel's capital. Netanyahu told India Today magazine in an interview over the weekend that while Israel was disappointed by India's vote, the relationship between Tel Aviv and New Delhi remained strong. "Yes, naturally we were disappointed, but this

visit is a testimony that our relationship is moving on so many fronts forward," Netanyahu said. During Netanyahu's six-day visit Israel and India are expected to sign agreements on cybersecurity, energy and space cooperation, according to India's External Affairs Ministry.

A large Israeli business contingent is travelling with Netanyahu and on Monday evening Netanyahu will attend the India-Israel CEO Forum Meeting. Netanyahu's schedule includes a visit to Agra, to visit the Taj Mahal, and to Gujarat, prime minister Modi's home state. He will also visit India's business capital Mumbai where apart from meeting business leaders he is also slated to meet with the leaders of India's tiny Jewish community.

### Unemployment row! Anantnag comes first in highest number.

Sameer Kashmiri: Anantnag: As the Anantnag district comes number one in terms of the highest number of jobless youth in valley on the other hand thousands of jobless youth registered recently on few government advertised teacher posts in District Anantnag. Sources told to that the telecom centers in District Anantnag were seen crowded by jobless youth who are registering themselves in recently advertised teachers posts in district Anantnag. Out of 320 include 192 General teachers, 96 science/Math and 32 Urdu posts thousands of unemployed youth registered for these teacher's posts in Anantnag district. The government is playing with our degrees as they only advertised 320 posts for district Anantnag, said Aamir Rasool a PG student. As per the government figures, there are 88 thousand educated youth in the state without jobs. However, as per the figures, South Kashmir's Anantnag district has highest number of jobless youth in entire Kashmir Valley. Out of 42219 unemployed youth, 6586 from Anantnag. JKSSB has recently advertised teachers post in valley however District Anantnag got only 320 posts. While talking to the Kashmir news bureau a telecom center said that I have no idea about how many students applied for these teachers' posts in my center. We are busy from last two weeks only submitting of forms for these posts; however girls applied for these posts more than boys. He added. Meanwhile Kashmir news Bureau received several calls from the Rehbar-e-Kbel aspirants also (KNB)
